

Dear Hollin Hall Families,

The time has FINALLY come... It's SUMMER CAMP TIME!

Hollin Hall Summer Day Camp (HHSDC) will begin June 13th, and run through August 19th (If FCPS changes their schedule, we will do our best to accommodate). Each camper will be able to sign up on a week-by-week selection. Our spaces are limited due to following mandated physical distancing guidelines set by the Governor and VDSS, and the CDC.

The Nitty Gritty:

The HHSDC rate is a flat rate of \$320/week. The price is the same regardless of your child's age. No other sibling discounts will apply. If you sign up for a week, and you decide not to come, tuition is paid *regardless if your camper is attending or not*. This fee will cover performers/vendors/entertainers/supplies throughout June, July, and August.

The following weeks are available and *must be indicated on your registration form*:

June: 13-17, 20-24, 27-July1 July: 5-8, 11-15, 18-22, 25-29 August: 1-5, 8-12, 15-19

HHSDC will be similar to last year as we continue to work with COVID and staff restrictions, with a lot of creative and spectacular activities planned here at the school, and around the local community. Smaller group sizes are planned for field trips while on the bus as well as at trip locations. Siblings will ride together, if able to be grouped by age together. We have a full summer planned of adventure, swimming, and entertainment here at the school and in the community. Masks are required at all times.

If we are comfortable, we may have opportunities such as Medieval Times, Fun Land, or Ziplining. There will be an additional weekly tuition fee of \$25-\$30 added for those fieldtrips, should we be able to offer them.

All campers are responsible for bringing a lunch (unless it's special lunch day), and we will provide morning and afternoon snacks.

Please complete all necessary paperwork provided on our website, and submit to the office, with a non-refundable \$150 registration fee (or \$225 for families with more than one camper) by Friday, February 18th, to reserve their space for camp! For your convenience, there is a check list within the registration form of paperwork requirements.
